

Additional opportunities for public comment in the Navy's National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process will occur after the publication of the Draft EIS in Summer 2020.

On January 24, 2020, the Navy announced its intent to prepare an EIS and hold public scoping meetings for revitalization of NAVWAR (Naval Information Warfare Systems Command) facilities on the Navy OTC at Naval Base Point Loma, California. Pursuant to NEPA, the Navy is preparing an EIS to evaluate the potential environmental effects associated with revitalization of the OTC to support NAVWAR's current and future operational readiness. The EIS will also address the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as it relates to nonfederal development within the proposed alternatives. The Navy is proposing to demolish existing facilities and construct new buildings, utilities, and infrastructure at the OTC. Specific proposed actions could include Navy recapitalization of the site or redevelopment through a public-private development, including the consideration of a potential Transit Center.

The Navy held two public scoping meetings, February 13 and February 19, 2020, to receive written comments on issues to be considered for analysis in the EIS. Navy representatives were available at poster stations to provide information about the project and answer questions. Project fact sheets and informational posters that were on display at the public scoping meetings are available on the project website at www.NAVWAR-revitalization.com/documents/.


The 30-day public scoping period ends on Monday, February 24, 2020. Details on how to submit written comments are provided above.
